CHAPTER ____

1 AN ACT concerning

State Personnel - Disability Retirement Benefits - Employees of Boards of Education Offset for Workers' Compensation Benefits - Exclusion

4 FOR the purpose of providing that a retiree who receives a disability retirement benefit

5 as a former employee of a county board of education or the Board of School

6 Commissioners of Baltimore City or a designated beneficiary of the retiree is not

7 subject to an offset of those benefits under a certain provision of the Code due to

8 receipt of workers' compensation benefits; providing that the retiree or designated

9 beneficiary is subject to an offset of the workers' compensation benefits under a

10 certain provision of the Code; and generally relating to the offset of benefits of a

11 retiree who receives a disability retirement benefit as a former employee of a county

12 board of education or the Board of School Commissioners of Baltimore City.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 Article - State Personnel and Pensions

21 29-118.

22 (a) (1) [This] EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION,

23 THIS section applies to a retiree and any designated beneficiary.

(2) (I) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A RETIREE WHO RECEIVES
 A DISABILITY RETIREMENT BENEFIT AS A FORMER EMPLOYEE OF A COUNTY
 BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE
 CITY OR A DESIGNATED BENEFICIARY OF THAT RETIREE.

5 (II) A RETIREE WHO RECEIVES A DISABILITY BENEFIT AS A
6 FORMER EMPLOYEE OF A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE BOARD OF
7 SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY OR A DESIGNATED BENEFICIARY OF
8 THAT RETIREE IS SUBJECT TO § 9-610 OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE.

9 (b) (1) The Board of Trustees shall reduce a disability retirement benefit by any 10 related workers' compensation benefits paid or payable after the effective date of 11 retirement if the workers' compensation benefits:

12 (i) are paid or payable while a pension is paid or payable; and

(ii) are for an accidental personal injury or occupational diseasearising out of and in the course of the retiree's employment by a participating employer.

(2) A retirement allowance may not be reduced to be less than the sum of
the retiree's annuity and the amount authorized to be deducted for health insurance
premiums.

(c) The retirement allowance to be reduced under this section is the retirementallowance at retirement without any cost-of-living adjustment and is retroactive.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 1997.
