	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding § 3-2A-01(b) of the Education Article, the initial terms of members of the Baltimore County Board of Education elected in November 1998 shall be as follows:
19 20	(1) (i) The four members who received the highest number of votes among the members elected from districts shall each serve a term of 4 years; and
21 22 t	(ii) The three remaining members elected from districts shall each serve a term of 2 years.
23 24	(2) (i) The two members who received the highest number of votes among the members elected at large shall each serve a term of 4 years; and
25 26	(ii) The two remaining members elected at large shall each serve a term of 2 years.

30 1	SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the members of the Baltimore County Board of Education serving on June 30, 1998 shall continue to serve until December 1, 1998, at which time the terms of all incumbent appointed members of the Board shall terminate.

32 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 33 July 1, 1998.
