FOR the purpose of repealing the authority of the Governor to appoint certain members of the Baltimore County Board of Education; altering the number of members of the Board; providing for the election of the members of the Board, except for the student member; specifying the terms of the members initially elected to the Baltimore County Board of Education; specifying that certain incumbent members shall continue to serve until the elected members take office; terminating the terms of the incumbent appointed members; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to the election of the members of the Baltimore County Board of Education.
