A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Construction Apprenticeship Assistance Program

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Construction Apprenticeship Assistance Program in

- 4 the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation; requiring the Division of
- 5 Employment and Training to administer the Program; requiring the Program to
- 6 award certain grants as provided by the State budget and based on certain criteria;
- 7 authorizing the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation to adopt certain
- 8 regulations; requiring the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation to adopt
- 9 certain regulations; requiring the grants to be distributed at a certain time and to a
- 10 certain extent; and generally relating to the Construction Apprenticeship Assistance
- 11 Program.

12 BY adding to

- 13 Article Labor and Employment
- 14 Section 11-601 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 6. Miscellaneous Programs"
- 15 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 16 (1991 Volume and 1996 Supplement)
- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 Article - Labor and Employment

- 20 SUBTITLE 6. MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS.
- 21 11-601.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, A "PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY" MEANS A PERSON THAT
THE MARYLAND APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINING COUNCIL APPROVES UNDER §
11-405(B) OF THIS TITLE.

25 (B) THERE IS A CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM IN26 THE DEPARTMENT.

27 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE
28 PROGRAM IS TO DEVELOP A WELL-TRAINED, PRODUCTIVE CONSTRUCTION
29 WORKFORCE WHICH MEETS THE NEEDS OF THE STATE'S ECONOMY.

1 (D) THE DIVISION SHALL ADMINISTER THE CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP 2 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

3 (E) AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET, THE CONSTRUCTION
4 APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL AWARD GRANTS TO ELIGIBLE
5 PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITIES THAT OPERATE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS IN THE
6 STATE.

7 (F) THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT ARE NECESSARY TO 8 CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

9 (G) BY REGULATION, THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH:

10 (1) CRITERIA TO DETERMINE THE ELIGIBILITY OF PRIVATE SECTOR 11 ENTITIES; AND

12 (2) AN APPLICATION PROCESS FOR DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY.

13 (H) GRANTS THAT THE CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE14 PROGRAM AWARDS UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE BASED ON:

15 (1) THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS IN A PROGRAM OPERATED BY AN16 ELIGIBLE PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY; AND

17 (2) DEMONSTRATED SHORTAGES OF SKILLED CONSTRUCTION18 WORKERS IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PROGRAM IS LOCATED.

(I) THE GRANTS SHALL CONSIST OF A MAXIMUM OF \$1,000 FOR EACH20 APPRENTICE IN AN ELIGIBLE PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY.

(J) IN MAKING GRANTS, THE CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE
 PROGRAM SHALL GIVE PRIORITY TO APPLICANTS IN COUNTIES WITH THE HIGHEST
 DEMONSTRATED SHORTAGE OF SKILLED WORKERS.

24 (K) THE CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL25 DISTRIBUTE A GRANT AWARDED TO A PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY:

26 (1) AT THE END OF A PROGRAM YEAR; AND

27 (2) ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT EACH APPRENTICE HAS COMPLETED28 THE PROGRAM YEAR.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect30 October 1, 1997.

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
