A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 State Procurement - Recipients of Proceeds of General Obligation Bonds - Requirements

3 FOR the purpose of altering the scope of the State Procurement Law to require a person

- 4 who receives any proceeds of any general obligation bonds of this State to comply
- 5 with the general procurement law of this State under certain circumstances; and
- 6 generally relating to the requirements of recipients of proceeds of general
- obligation bonds of this State. 7

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Finance and Procurement 15

17 Except as otherwise expressly provided by law, this Division II applied
--

18 (1) each expenditure by a unit under a procurement contract;

19 (2) each procurement by a unit on behalf of another unit, governmental 20 agency, or other entity; [and]

21 (3) each procurement by a unit, even if a resulting procurement contract will 22 involve no expenditure by the State and will produce revenue for the State, for services 23 that are to be provided for the benefit of:

- 24 (i) State officials, State employees, or students at a State facility, 25 including a school, hospital, institution, or recreational facility;
- 26 (ii) clients or patients at a State hospital or State institution;
 - (iii) the public at a State recreational facility; or

1 (iv) the public at a State transportation facility or State higher 2 education facility, as required by the Board[.]; AND

3 (4) EACH EXPENDITURE OR PROCUREMENT BY A PERSON WHO
4 RECEIVES ANY PROCEEDS OF A GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND OF THIS STATE WHEN
5 UTILIZING THE PROCEEDS OR ANY MATCHING FUNDS OF THE PROCEEDS.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 1997.
