## 2 University of Maryland, College Park - Prohibition of the Unauthorized Removal of

- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from removing or causing the removal of
- 5 recyclable materials from certain places at the University of Maryland, College
- 6 Park; providing that recyclable materials become the property of the University of
- 7 Maryland, College Park under certain circumstances; providing penalties for
- 8 violations of this Act; providing for the construction of this Act; defining a certain
- 9 term; and generally relating to the prohibition of the unauthorized removal of
- 10 recyclable materials at the University of Maryland, College Park.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Education
- 19 13-703.
- 20 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 21 INDICATED.
- 22 (2) "RECYCLABLE MATERIALS" MEANS MATERIALS THAT:
- 23 (I) IF NOT RECYCLED, WOULD BECOME SOLID WASTE FOR
- 24 DISPOSAL IN A REFUSE DISPOSAL SYSTEM; AND
- 25 (II) MAY BE COLLECTED, SEPARATED, OR PROCESSED AND
- 26 RETURNED TO THE MARKETPLACE IN THE FORM OF RAW MATERIALS OR
- 27 PRODUCTS.
- 28 (3) "RECYCLABLE MATERIALS" INCLUDES PAPER, GLASS, METALS,
- 29 PLASTICS, AND CARDBOARD.

- 1 (B) RECYCLABLE MATERIALS THAT ARE SEPARATED FOR COLLECTION AT
- 2 THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND. COLLEGE PARK BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE
- 3 UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK WHEN PLACED FOR COLLECTION IN OR
- 4 NEAR DESIGNATED BINS OR LOCATIONS.
- 5 (C) A PERSON MAY NOT REMOVE OR CAUSE THE REMOVAL OF ANY
- 6 RECYCLABLE MATERIALS THAT ARE OWNED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND,
- 7 COLLEGE PARK UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY:
- 8 (1) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK; OR
- 9 (2) THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A COMPANY THAT IS AUTHORIZED 10 BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK TO REMOVE RECYCLABLE 11 MATERIALS.
- 12 (D) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT A LAW
- 13 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER FROM SEARCHING AND SEIZING ANY RECYCLABLE
- 14 MATERIALS OWNED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK.
- 15 (E) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY 16 OF A MISDEMEANOR AND IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$500 FOR EACH 17 VIOLATION.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 July 1, 1997.
