2 Carroll County - Board of County Commissioners - Composition

- 3 FOR the purpose of increasing the number of members on the Board of County
- 4 Commissioners of Carroll County; specifying that the Commissioners are to be
- 5 elected at large; submitting this Act to a referendum of the legally qualified voters
- of Carroll County; providing for the effect of a possible contingency; providing for
- 7 the application of this Act; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to the
- 8 membership of the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll County.
- 9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 10 The Public Local Laws of Carroll County
- 11 Section 3-1
- 12 Article 7 Public Local Laws of Maryland
- 13 (1976 Edition and 1996 Supplement, as amended)
- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 **Article 7 Carroll County**
- 17 3-1.
- 18 (a) There are [3] 5 County Commissioners for Carroll County WHO SHALL BE
- 19 ELECTED AT LARGE.
- 20 (B) Each County Commissioner is entitled to:
- 21 (1) A salary of [\$32,500.00] \$32,500 a year; and
- 22 (2) An allowance for expenses incurred in the performance of the duties of
- 23 that office, as provided in the county budget.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That before this Act becomes
- 25 legally effective it shall first be submitted to a referendum of the legally qualified voters
- 26 of Carroll County at the general election to be held in November 1998 or, if a special
- 27 election is held throughout Carroll County prior to the general election held in November
- 28 1998, at that special election. The cost of the election, if any, shall be paid by the county
- 29 governing body. The county governing body and the Board of Supervisors of Elections of
- 30 Carroll County shall do those things necessary and proper to provide for and hold the

- 1 referendum required by this section. There shall be printed on the ballots or ballot labels
- 2 to be used at the election the title "Board of County Commissioners Expansion to Five
- 3 Commissioners" and underneath the title, on separate lines, options for a voter to select
- 4 "For Increasing Size of the Board" or "Against Increasing Size of the Board". If a
- 5 majority of the votes cast on the question are "For Increasing Size of the Board", the
- 6 provisions of this Act shall become effective for the election of the Board of County
- 7 Commissioners in 1998 if this question appears on the ballot at a special election held on
- 8 or before June 1, 1998. If this question appears on a ballot at an election held after June
- 9 1, 1998, and a majority of the votes cast on the question are "For Increasing Size of the
- 10 Board", the provisions of this Act shall become effective for the election of the Board of
- 11 County Commissioners in 2002. If a majority of the votes cast on the question are
- 12 "Against Increasing Size of the Board", the provisions of this Act are of no effect and null
- 13 and void.
- 14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding Section 2
- 15 of this Act, if the majority of voters of Carroll County elect to adopt home rule under the
- 16 provisions of Article XI-A or Article XI-F of the Constitution of Maryland at the same
- 17 election when the question under Section 2 of this Act appears on the ballot, the
- 18 provisions of this Act, and the results of any election conducted pursuant to this Act, are
- 19 void and of no effect.
- 20 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be
- 21 construed to have any effect on the County Commissioners of Carroll County serving on
- 22 the effective date of this Act, but shall be applied, in accordance with Section 2 of this
- 23 Act, to the election of the Board of County Commissioners in 1998 or 2002.
- 24 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions
- 25 of Section 2 of this Act and for the sole purpose of providing for the referendum required
- 26 by Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 1997.
