CHAPTER ____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Talbot County - Board of Education - Student Member**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the position of student member on the Board of
4 Education of Talbot County; establishing certain qualifications and terms for the
5 student member on the County Board; requiring the position of student member to
6 alternate annually between certain schools; requiring certain schools to adopt
7 certain procedures for the election of the student member; and generally relating to
8 a student member on the Board of Education for Talbot County.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Education**

17 3-113.1.

18 (A) (1) THERE SHALL BE ONE NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER ON THE
19 TALBOT COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

20 (2) THE STUDENT MEMBER SHALL ADVISE THE OTHER MEMBERS OF
21 THE COUNTY BOARD ON THE VIEWPOINT OF STUDENTS WHO ATTEND TALBOT
22 COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

1 (B) (1) THE NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL
2 BE:

3 (I) A REGULARLY ENROLLED 11TH OR 12TH GRADE STUDENT IN
4 GOOD STANDING AT A TALBOT COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL;

5 (II) QUALIFIED ACCORDING TO ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS
6 ESTABLISHED BY THE COUNTY BOARD; AND

7 (III) OF GOOD CHARACTER.

8 (2) (I) THE STUDENT MEMBER SHALL BE ELECTED FOR A 1-YEAR
9 TERM DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR PRIOR TO THE SCHOOL YEAR THAT THE MEMBER
10 IS TO SERVE ON THE COUNTY BOARD.

11 (II) FOR THE 1997-1998 SCHOOL YEAR, THE STUDENT MEMBER
12 SHALL BE ELECTED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE 1997-1998
13 SCHOOL YEAR.

14 (3) THE POSITION OF STUDENT MEMBER SHALL ALTERNATE
15 ANNUALLY BETWEEN A STUDENT FROM ST. MICHAELS HIGH SCHOOL AND EASTON
16 HIGH SCHOOL.

17 (4) THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF EACH OF THE
18 RESPECTIVE HIGH SCHOOLS SHALL ADOPT PROCEDURES FOR THE ELECTION OF
19 THE STUDENT MEMBER FROM THAT HIGH SCHOOL.

20 (5) IF A VACANCY IN THE POSITION OF STUDENT MEMBER OCCURS
21 DURING THE TERM OF THE STUDENT MEMBER, THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT
22 ASSOCIATION OF THE HIGH SCHOOL OF THAT STUDENT SHALL ELECT ANOTHER
23 STUDENT MEMBER TO FILL THE VACANCY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS PROCEDURES.

24 (6) UNLESS INVITED TO ATTEND BY AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A
25 MAJORITY OF THE COUNTY BOARD, THE STUDENT MEMBER MAY NOT ATTEND AN
26 EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE COUNTY BOARD.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
28 July 1, 1997.
