A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Tasting Days)**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the number of days during which the Harford County Liquor
5 Control Board may issue tasting or sampling licenses; altering a fee; and generally
6 relating to alcoholic beverages in Harford County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
9 Section 8-407(c) and (f)
10 Annotated Code of Maryland
11 (1996 Replacement Volume)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 8-407.

16 (c) Each of the respective tasting or sampling licenses under this subsection is
17 effective for a maximum of [24] 52 days in any licensing period.

18 (f) The cost of the CWBT license for holders of a BWL license is [\$250] \$400
19 each year in addition to the cost of the BWL license.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 June 1, 1997.
