- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article 27A - Public Defender**

- 14 (a) The Office of Public Defender is hereby established in the executive branch of
- 15 the government of the State of Maryland. The head of the Office shall be the Public
- 16 Defender, who shall be appointed by the board of trustees, and who shall serve at the
- 17 pleasure of the board of trustees. To be qualified for appointment as Public Defender, a
- 18 person must be an attorney-at-law, admitted to practice law in the State of Maryland by
- 19 the Court of Appeals of Maryland, and engaged in the practice of law for a period of five
- 20 (5) years prior to his appointment. The Public Defender shall receive such salary as
- 21 provided in the budget, BUT NOT LESS THAN THE SALARY OF A JUDGE OF THE
- 22 CIRCUIT COURT. [and] THE PUBLIC DEFENDER shall not engage in the private practice
- 23 of law.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 1997.
