2 Business Organizations - Right to Associate - Services and Membership

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain business organizations that provide certain

- 16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "BUSINESS ORGANIZATION" MEANS ANY PERSON OR
- 17 ORGANIZATION THAT REPRESENTS OR ADVOCATES ON BEHALF OF ANY OTHER
- 18 PERSON OR GROUP RELATING TO BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT ISSUES AND CHARGES
- 19 THE PERSON OR GROUP A MEMBERSHIP FEE OR DUES.
- 20 (B) A BUSINESS ORGANIZATION THAT OFFERS REPRESENTATION,
- 21 ADVOCACY, INFORMATIONAL, OR OTHER SERVICES REGARDING BUSINESS ISSUES
- 22 TO THE MEMBERS OF THE ORGANIZATION WHO PAY FEES OR DUES, SHALL
- 23 PROVIDE FREE IDENTICAL SERVICES IN THE ORGANIZATION TO ANY PERSON WHO
- 24 OPERATES A PLACE OF BUSINESS IN THE STATE.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
