11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Natural Resources**

15 (b) The Department shall prepare fishery management plans for the following

5 (15) Red drum;

8 (18) Horseshoe crabs; [and]

10 (20) TAUTOG;

11 (21) BLACK SEA BASS; AND

12 (22) SCUP.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
