1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Libraries - Funding**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the per capita dollar amount that is required to be provided
4 annually to each county public library system participating in the State's minimum
5 library program; and providing for the application of this Act.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Education**

14 23-503.

15 (b) (1) Each year, each county public library system that participates in the
16 minimum library program shall be provided [\$9.25]\$10.25 for each resident of the county,
17 to be used for operating and capital expenses. The State shall share in this amount.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
2 applicable beginning with the fiscal year that begins on July 1, 1998.

3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 1997.
