3 FOR the purpose of altering the per capita dollar amount that is required to be provided

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Education

14 23-503.

(b) (1) Each year, each county public library system that participates in the
minimum library program shall be provided [\$9.25]\$10.25 for each resident of the county,
to be used for operating and capital expenses. The State shall share in this amount.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 2 applicable beginning with the fiscal year that begins on July 1, 1998.
