12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) (1) Each employer:
- 17 (i) shall set regular pay periods; and

(ii) except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, shall payeach employee at least once in every 2 weeks or twice in each month.

20 (2) An employer may pay an administrative, executive, or professional 21 employee less frequently than required under paragraph (1)(ii) of this subsection.

- (b) If the regular payday of an employee is a nonwork day, an employer shall paythe employee on the preceding workday.
- 24 (c) Each employer shall pay a wage:
- 25 (1) in United States currency; [or]

26 (2) by a check that, on demand, is convertible at face value into United27 States currency; OR

1 (3) BY A DIRECT DEPOSIT OF THE WAGE OF AN EMPLOYEE INTO A 2 PERSONAL BANK ACCOUNT OF THE EMPLOYEE THAT IS:

3 (I) SELECTED BY THE EMPLOYEE;

4 (II) PROVIDED BY THE EMPLOYER IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN 5 AUTHORIZATION OF THE EMPLOYEE; OR

6 (III) PROVIDED BY THE EMPLOYER IF THE EMPLOYEE FAILS TO
7 SELECT OR ACCEPT A PERSONAL BANK ACCOUNT UNDER SUBITEMS (I) OR (II) OF
8 THIS ITEM.

9 [(d) This section does not prohibit the direct deposit of the wage of an employee 10 into a personal bank account of the employee in accordance with an authorization of the 11 employee.]

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 1997.
