A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Police Dogs - Liability for Harm

3 FOR the purpose of making a person liable for the purchase, care, and training costs of

- 4 a replacement police dog if the person, while in the act of committing a crime for
- 5 which the person is later convicted, kills, maims, or otherwise harms a police dog
- 6 used by a law enforcement agency so as to force the police dog out of service;
- 7 defining certain terms; and generally relating to liability for harm to police dogs.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS18 INDICATED.

(2) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS A GOVERNMENTAL POLICE
 FORCE, SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, SECURITY FORCE, OR OTHER AGENCY OF THE
 STATE OR A COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY, OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE
 STATE.

23 (3) "POLICE DOG" MEANS A DOG THAT IS REGISTERED WITH AND USED24 BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS OFFICIAL DUTIES.

(B) A PERSON WHO, WHILE IN THE ACT OF COMMITTING A CRIME FOR WHICH
THE PERSON IS LATER CONVICTED, KILLS, MAIMS, OR OTHERWISE HARMS A POLICE
DOG USED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SO AS TO FORCE THE POLICE DOG
OUT OF SERVICE IS LIABLE FOR THE PURCHASE, CARE, AND TRAINING COSTS OF A
REPLACEMENT POLICE DOG.

- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 2 October 1, 1997.
