### 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 19 **Article - Transportation**

- 21 (a) There is a Maryland Aviation Commission.
- 22 (c) (1) The Commission shall consist of [nine] 10 voting members:
- 23 (i) [Eight] NINE appointed by the Governor with the advice and
- 24 consent of the Senate; and
- 25 (ii) The Secretary of Transportation, who shall be the Chairman of the
- 26 Commission.
- 27 (2) The Secretary of Business and Economic Development shall serve as a
- 28 nonvoting ex officio Commission member.

- 1 (3) AT LEAST ONE MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION APPOINTED BY THE
- 2 GOVERNOR SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THE 32ND LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 October 1, 1997.
