- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "WITHOUT THAT PERSON'S KNOWLEDGE" MEANS THAT
- 21 THE PERSON IS UNAWARE THAT A SUBSTANCE WITH THE ABILITY TO ALTER THE
- 22 PERSON'S ABILITY TO APPRAISE CONDUCT OR TO DECLINE PARTICIPATION IN OR
- 23 COMMUNICATE UNWILLINGNESS TO PARTICIPATE IN CONDUCT IS DISTRIBUTED OR

- 2 (B) (A) A PERSON MAY NOT DISTRIBUTE OR ADMINISTER A CONTROLLED
