- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that under certain circumstances a lien on a boat may be
- 4 established for charges incurred for towage services; requiring the Department of
- 5 Natural Resources to provide a boat lien notice system; providing certain
- 6 requirements for filing a boat lien notice with the Department; providing that a boat
- 7 lien notice provides certain notice to certain third parties; requiring the Department
- 8 to record a boat lien notice with the owner's certificate of number; providing that
- 9 the Department may not transfer ownership if the money owed is recorded on the
- new title; providing that the Department may transfer ownership if the money owed
- is released by the creditor or lienholder; and generally relating to boat liens.

- 27 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 28 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 **Article - Commercial Law** 2 16-202. 3 (b) (1) Any person who, with the consent of the owner, has custody of a boat 4 and who, at the request of the owner, provides a service to or materials for the boat, has 5 a lien on the boat for any charge incurred for any: 6 (i) Repair, rebuilding, maintenance, servicing, or wet or dry wharfage; 7 (ii) Storage OR TOWAGE SERVICES; or 8 (iii) Parts or accessories. (2) A lien is created under this subsection when any charges giving rise to 10 the lien are incurred. 11 16-204. 12 (A) Surrender or delivery of the property subject to the lien discharges that lien 13 against a third person who is without notice of the lien, but does not discharge the lien 14 against the owner or against a third party who has notice of the lien. 15 (B) A THIRD PARTY IS DEEMED TO HAVE NOTICE OF A LIEN. WHETHER OR 16 NOT THE LIEN HAS BEEN NOTED ON THE TITLE DOCUMENT, IF A BOAT LIEN NOTICE 17 IS ON FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES UNDER § 8-703(C) OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES ARTICLE. 19 16-207. 20 (b) (1) The lienor shall publish notice of the time, place, and terms of the sale 21 and a full description of the property to be sold once a week for the two weeks 22 immediately preceding the sale in one or more newspapers of general circulation in the 23 county where the sale is to be held. 24 (2) In addition, the lienor shall send the notice by registered or certified 25 mail at least 10 days before the sale to: (i) The owner of the property, all holders of perfected security 26 27 interests in the property INCLUDING ALL BOAT LIENHOLDERS WHO HAVE FILED A 28 BOAT LIEN NOTICE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, and, in the 29 case of a sale of a motor vehicle or mobile home, the Motor Vehicle Administration; 30 (ii) The person who incurred the charges which give rise to the lien, if 31 the address of the owner is unknown and cannot be ascertained by the exercise of 32 reasonable diligence; or 33 (iii) "General delivery" at the post office of the city or county where 34 the business of the lienor is located, if the address of both the owner and the person who

35 incurred the charges is unknown and cannot be ascertained by the exercise of reasonable

36 diligence.

	(2) A LIENHOLDER MAY FILE A BOAT LIEN NOTICE WITH THE DEPARTMENT BY PROVIDING THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT:
11	(I) THE NAME OF THE LIENHOLDER;
12 13	(II) THE NAME OF THE OWNER AND AN IDENTIFICATION OF THE BOAT SUBJECT TO THE BOAT LIEN;

20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31	(c) (1) Certificates of number issued under this section shall be valid for a period not to exceed 2 years. The owner of the vessel may apply every other year for renewal of the certificate. The renewed certificate shall expire on December 31 of the calendar year following the year the certificate is issued. The fee for a 2-year certificate for vessels is \$24. Vessels 16 feet in length or less and equipped with a 7 1/2 horsepower motor or less are exempt from this fee. The fee to replace a lost, destroyed, or corrected certificate is \$2. The Department shall record ANY BOAT LIEN NOTICE FILED UNDER § 8-703(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE, AND any transaction or transfer of numbered boats. The Department may record any amount of money owing on a vessel required to be numbered at the time of sale. The Department may not effect a transfer of ownership until the amount of money owed as shown on the records of the Department is fully paid or [recorded on the new title] THE AMOUNT OF MONEY OWED IS RELEASED BY THE CREDITOR OR LIENHOLDER. Any vessel that is required to be numbered under this section that is exempt prior to January 1, 1974 shall be exempt from payment of this title tax.
33 34	(2) Emergency rescue boats that belong to fire departments or rescue squads in Maryland:
35	(i) Shall be exempt from all registration fees; but
36	(ii) Shall apply for a registration renewal every 3 years.
37 38	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.
