CHAPTER ____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - The Lucille Maurer Leadership Library

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$300,000
- 4 \$225,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Academy of Leadership at the
- 5 University of Maryland College Park for certain acquisition, development, or
- 6 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to
- 7 a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing
- 8 generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 MARYLAND. That:

- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as The Lucille Maurer
- 13 Leadership Library Loan of 1997 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i)
- 14 \$300,000 \$225,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with
- 15 Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of
- 16 State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works
- 17 and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State
- 18 Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 19 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a
- 20 single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 21 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

- 1 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 2 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the
- 3 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on
- 4 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,
- $5\ \ for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees:$
- 6 as a grant to the Academy of Leadership at the University of Maryland College Park
- 7 (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design, repair,
- 8 renovation, reconstruction, and construction of, and for the provision of capital
- 9 equipment and furnishings for, The Lucille Maurer Leadership Library, to be housed at
- 10 the Academy of Leadership at the University of Maryland College Park, the Library to
- 11 contain archives dealing with aspects of leadership in and among women, and to be
- 12 named in memory and in honor of the late Lucille Maurer, former State Treasurer and
- 13 former member of the House of Delegates of Maryland.
- 14 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate
- 15 and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and when due
- 16 and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of
- 17 issuance of the bonds.
- 18 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 19 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching
- 20 fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or
- 21 indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of
- 22 the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to
- 23 the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching
- 24 fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works
- 25 shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1,
- 26 1999, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund
- 27 will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 28 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- 29 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in
- 30 this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified
- 31 by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 33 June 1, 1997.
