19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 (d) (1) An applicant for a certified social worker license shall have:

(i) A master's degree from an accredited college or university and
 based on a graduate social work program accredited by the Council on Social Work
 Education: and

4 (ii) 2 years of social work experience as a social worker where
5 face-to-face supervision is part of the employment contract and the supervisor is a
6 licensed certified social worker and is provided by and accountable to the employer after
7 receiving the master's degree.

8 (2) [An] (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS
 9 SUBSECTION, AN applicant for a certified social worker-clinical license shall have:

10 [(i)] 1. A master's degree in social work and documentation of 11 clinical course work from an accredited college or university and based on a graduate 12 social work program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education; and

13 [(ii)]-2. 2 years of supervised clinical social work experience of at
 14 least 3,000 hours after receiving the master's degree with a minimum of 144 hours of
 15 periodic direct face-to-face supervision provided in not less than 2 consecutive years and
 16 not more than 6 consecutive years and where the supervision is part of the employment
 17 contract and the supervisor is a licensed certified social worker-clinical and is provided by
 18 and accountable to the employer.

24 (g) (1) If the supervision required for a certified social worker license under

25 subsection (d)(1) of this section was not available to the applicant while the applicant was

26 obtaining the required 2 years of experience, the Board may waive the supervision

27 requirement on the request of the applicant.

Until January 1, [1995] 1999, the Board shall waive the examination requirements of this title for an applicant for a certified social worker-clinical license if the applicant:

(1) Pays the application fee required by the Board under § 19-303 of thissubtitle;

37 (2) Was a licensed certified social worker on July 1, 1993; and

38 (3) Was eligible for inclusion on the vendorship list maintained by the Board39 on July 1, 1993.

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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed 2 retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect applicants who applied on 3 or after January 1, 1995.

4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 1997.
