BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Transportation** 21 22 15-711.

(A) TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH STATE AND FEDERAL TAX LAWS, A

- 2 8-626 OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE.
- 3 (B) THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION SHALL REVIEW EACH SCHOOL'S
- 4 QUARTERLY WAGE REPORT TO ENSURE THAT THE SCHOOL HAS WITHHELD THE
- 5 PROPER TAXES FOR EACH LICENSED INSTRUCTOR ON RECORD WITH THE
- 6 ADMINISTRATION EMPLOYED BY THE SCHOOL WHEN ISSUING A LICENSE OR
- 7 RENEWING A LICENSE OF A DRIVERS' SCHOOL, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL
- 8 VERIFY THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER THAT:
- 9 (1) ALL TAXES, UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE CONTRIBUTIONS,
- 10 REIMBURSEMENT PAYMENTS, AND INTEREST NOT BARRED BY LIMITATIONS AND
- 11 PAYABLE BY THE DRIVERS' SCHOOL TO THE COMPTROLLER, THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 12 ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION, AND THE SECRETARY OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC
- 13 DEVELOPMENT ARE PAID; OR
- 14 (2) PAYMENT HAS BEEN PROVIDED FOR IN A MANNER SATISFACTORY
- 15 TO THE UNIT RESPONSIBLE FOR COLLECTION.
- 16 (C) (B) IF THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION FINDS ANY
- 17 DISCREPANCY BETWEEN A SCHOOL'S LIST OF LICENSED INSTRUCTORS ON RECORD
- 18 WITH THE ADMINISTRATION AND THE LIST OF INSTRUCTORS IN THE SCHOOL'S
- 19 OUARTERLY REPORT FOR WHOM TAXES HAVE BEEN WITHHELD INFORMATION
- 20 OBTAINED THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER:
- 21 (1) THE SCHOOL SHALL BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO ACCOUNT FOR
- 22 THE DISCREPANCY; AND
- 23 (2) FAILURE TO ACCOUNT FOR THE DISCREPANCY SHALL:
- 24 (I) BE DEEMED THE COMMISSION OF A FRAUD IN CONNECTION
- 25 WITH THE BUSINESS CONDUCTED UNDER THE LICENSE UNDER § 15-710(A)(4) OF THIS
- 26 SUBTITLE; AND
- 27 (II) RESULT IN SUSPENSION OF THE SCHOOL'S LICENSE BY THE
- 28 ADMINISTRATION.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 30 October 1, 1997.
