- 17 (A) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGES OF
- 18 BALTIMORE COUNTY SHALL ESTABLISH A CITIZENS' EDUCATIONAL ADVISORY
- 19 COMMITTEE FOR PURPOSES OF:
- 20 (1) ADVISING THE BOARD AND THE CHANCELLOR; AND
- 21 (2) FACILITATING THE ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS IN THE
- 22 COMMUNITY COLLEGES.
- 23 (B) (1) THE COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL
- 24 CONSIST OF 12 MEMBERS, INCLUDING PARENTS, TEACHERS, STUDENTS, BUSINESS
- 25 LEADERS, AND OTHER CITIZENS FROM BALTIMORE COUNTY.
- 26 (2) THREE MEMBERS SHALL REPRESENT EACH OF THE THREE
- 27 COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND THREE MEMBERS SHALL SERVE AT-LARGE.
- 28 (3) NO MORE THAN TWO TEACHERS FROM EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE
- 29 MAY SERVE ON THE COMMITTEE AT THE SAME TIME.
