A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County - Community Colleges - Citizens' Educational Advisory Committee**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Trustees of the Community Colleges of
4 Baltimore County to establish a citizens' educational advisory committee for certain
5 purposes; requiring the committee to consist of certain members; and generally
6 relating to the citizens' educational advisory committee for the community colleges
7 in Baltimore County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 16-403.1.

17 (A) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGES OF
18 BALTIMORE COUNTY SHALL ESTABLISH A CITIZENS' EDUCATIONAL ADVISORY
19 COMMITTEE FOR PURPOSES OF:

20 (1) ADVISING THE BOARD AND THE CHANCELLOR; AND

21 (2) FACILITATING THE ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS IN THE
22 COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

23 (B) (1) THE COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL
24 CONSIST OF 12 MEMBERS, INCLUDING PARENTS, TEACHERS, STUDENTS, BUSINESS
25 LEADERS, AND OTHER CITIZENS FROM BALTIMORE COUNTY.

26 (2) THREE MEMBERS SHALL REPRESENT EACH OF THE THREE
27 COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND THREE MEMBERS SHALL SERVE AT-LARGE.

28 (3) NO MORE THAN TWO TEACHERS FROM EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE
29 MAY SERVE ON THE COMMITTEE AT THE SAME TIME.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 1997.
