3	FOR the purpose of establishing a Computer and Technology-Based Occupations
4	Apprenticeship Assistance Program in the Department of Labor, Licensing, and

7	budget and based on certain criteria; authorizing the Secretary of Labor, Licensing,

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 23 INDICATED.
- (2) "PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY" MEANS A PERSON THAT THE MARYLAND 24
- 25 APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINING COUNCIL APPROVES UNDER § 11-405(B) OF THIS
- 26 TITLE.
- (3) "COMPUTER AND TECHNOLOGY-BASED OCCUPATIONS" INCLUDES: 27
- 28 (I) COMPUTER PROGRAMMERS;
- 29 (II) COMPUTER TECHNICIANS; AND

2 3	(B) THERE IS A COMPUTER AND TECHNOLOGY-BASED OCCUPATIONS APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT.
6 7	(C) THE PURPOSE OF THE COMPUTER AND TECHNOLOGY-BASED OCCUPATIONS APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM IS TO DEVELOP A WELL-TRAINED, PRODUCTIVE WORKFORCE IN COMPUTER AND TECHNOLOGY-BASED OCCUPATIONS TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE STATE'S ECONOMY.
9 10	(D) THE DIVISION SHALL ADMINISTER THE COMPUTER AND TECHNOLOGY-BASED OCCUPATIONS APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
13	(E) AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET, THE COMPUTER AND TECHNOLOGY-BASED OCCUPATIONS APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL AWARD GRANTS TO ELIGIBLE PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITIES THAT OPERATE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS IN THE STATE.

23 24	(H) GRANTS UNDER THE COMPUTER AND TECHNOLOGY-BASED OCCUPATIONS APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE GIVEN TO PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITIES OFFERING APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS LOCATED IN AREAS DESIGNATED FOR GROWTH IN A COUNTY MASTER PLAN.
26 27	(I) THE GRANTS SHALL CONSIST OF A MAXIMUM OF \$1,000 FOR EACH APPRENTICE IN AN ELIGIBLE PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY.
	(J) THE COMPUTER AND TECHNOLOGY-BASED OCCUPATIONS APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL DISTRIBUTE A GRANT AWARDED TO A PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY:
31	(1) AT THE END OF A PROGRAM YEAR; AND
32	(2) ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT EACH APPRENTICE HAS COMPLETED THE PROGRAM YEAR

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
