- 3 FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 310 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1995,
- 4 the Somerset County Ward Brothers Homeplace Loan of 1995, to alter the name
- 5 of the loan, to alter the name of the recipient of the proceeds of the bonds, to alter
- 6 the purpose for which the proceeds of the bonds will be used, to alter the kind of
- 7 matching fund that will be provided, and to remove the historic easement.
- 8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 9 Chapter 310 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1995
- 10 Section 1
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Chapter 310 of the Acts of 1995

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That:
- 16 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 17 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Somerset County
- 18 [Ward Brothers Homeplace] SMITH ISLAND CONFERENCE CENTER Loan of 1995 in
- 19 a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$50,000 or (ii) the amount of the
- 20 matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be
- 21 evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized
- 22 by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in
- 23 accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article
- 24 and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 25 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a
- 26 single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 27 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 28 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 29 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the
- 30 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on

- 1 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,
- 2 for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees:
- 3 as a grant to the Board of Directors of [Ward Brothers Homeplace,] THE CRISFIELD
- 4 AND SMITH ISLAND CULTURAL ALLIANCE, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as
- 5 "the grantee") for the [restoration, including the repair and renovation, of the Ward
- 6 Brothers Homeplace at 3199 Sackertown Road in Crisfield, Maryland] PROVISION AND
- 7 STABILIZATION OF INFRASTRUCTURE, AND THE PROVISION OF CAPITAL
- 8 EQUIPMENT AND FURNISHINGS FOR THE SMITH ISLAND CONFERENCE CENTER.
- 9 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate
- 10 and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and when due
- 11 and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of
- 12 issuance of the bonds.
- 13 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 14 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching
- 15 fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or
- 16 indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of
- 17 the fund may consist of [real property or] in kind contributions. The fund may consist of
- 18 funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act OR REAL PROPERTY. In case of
- 19 any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as
- 20 matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's
- 21 decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 1997, to present evidence satisfactory to
- 22 the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence
- 23 is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the
- 24 State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund
- 25 shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess
- 26 of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be
- 27 canceled and be of no further effect.
- 28 [(6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey to
- 29 the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of its
- 30 interest:
- (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- 32 and
- 33 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 34 structures.
- 35 (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
- 36 and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.]
- 37 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 38 June 1, 1997.
