- 3 FOR the purpose of altering provisions of law relating to the issuance of special
- 4 organizational registration plates to restrict the depiction of a flag on an emblem or
- 5 logo displayed on such plates; requiring the Administration to provide a certain
- 6 notice to a person with special organizational registration plates displaying certain

## 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (a) The owner of a motor vehicle, or a lessee of the vehicle under a lease not
- 20 intended as security, or a director, officer, employee, or partner of a business entity that
- 21 owns the vehicle who is a member or, subject to subsection (c)(3) of this section, the
- 22 surviving spouse of a member, of an organization considered eligible by the
- 23 Administration may apply to the Administration for the assignment of a special
- 24 registration number if the vehicle is included in one of the following classes:
- 25 (1) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;
- 26 (2) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a manufacturer's rated capacity of one ton
- 27 or less; or
- 28 (3) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.

1 2	(b) (1) In this subsection, "motorcyclist organization" means a motorcyclist organization, institution, association, society, or corporation that:
3	(i) Is exempt from taxation under § 501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code; and
5 6	(ii) Is determined by the Administration to be eligible under this section.
	(2) The owner of a Class D (motorcycle) vehicle who is a member of a motorcyclist organization may apply to the Administration for the assignment of a special registration number for the vehicle.
10 11	(c) The Administration may issue and continue a special registration number under this section if:
14	(1) The owner of the motor vehicle submits, with the original application, proof satisfactory to the Administration that the owner of the vehicle is a member of a nonprofit organization and complies with the regulations adopted by the Administration under subsection (d) of this section;

28	(e) (1) In addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required under this title, an owner of a vehicle assigned a special registration under this section shall pay a fee determined by the Administration each time new registration plates are issued for the vehicle.

31 32	(i) May not exceed the amount required to enable the Administration to recover its costs under this section;
33 34	(ii) Shall be retained by the Administration for the purpose of recovering its cost under this section; and

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Motor Vehicle Administration shall notify a person to whom special organizational registration plates were issued under § 13-619(g)(1)(ii) of the Transportation Article before the effective date of this Act with an emblem or logo that is not authorized under this Act, at least 30 days before the end of the registration period for the vehicle for which the plates were issued, that the person is required to return the plates to the Motor Vehicle Administration by the end of the registration period.
33 34 35 36	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, upon the return of special organizational registration plates issued under § 13-619(g)(1)(ii) of the Transportation Article before the effective date of this Act with an emblem or logo that is not authorized under this Act and the renewal of the registration of the vehicle for which the plates were issued, the Motor Vehicle Administration shall issue to the owner of the vehicle replacement registration plates as otherwise authorized under Title 13 of the Transportation Article.

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SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 1997.
