A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Homeowner's Insurance - Covered Property Loss - Repair or Replacement Costs

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a policy or contract of homeowner's insurance that
- 4 contains a certain provision that the insurer will pay the cost to repair or replace the
- 5 damaged part of a building or other structure as settlement of a claim for covered
- 6 property loss may not be issued unless the policy or contract also provides that the
- 7 insurer will pay certain other costs associated with the damage or loss; requiring the
- 8 Maryland Insurance Commissioner to adopt regulations to implement the
- 9 provisions of this Act; and generally relating to repair or replacement costs for a
- 10 covered property loss in homeowner's insurance.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 **Article Insurance**
- 20 19-204.
- 21 A POLICY OR CONTRACT OF HOMEOWNER'S INSURANCE THAT CONTAINS A
- 22 PROVISION THAT THE INSURER WILL PAY THE COST TO REPAIR OR REPLACE THE
- 23 DAMAGED PART OF A BUILDING OR OTHER STRUCTURE AS SETTLEMENT OF A
- 24 CLAIM FOR COVERED PROPERTY LOSS MAY NOT BE ISSUED UNLESS THE POLICY OR
- 25 CONTRACT ALSO PROVIDES THAT THE INSURER WILL PAY COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH
- 26 THE DAMAGE OR LOSS THAT WILL CAUSE THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE
- 27 BUILDING OR OTHER STRUCTURE AFTER THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT TO BE NO
- 28 LESS THAN THE FAIR MARKET VALUE BEFORE THE LOSS OR DAMAGE.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Insurance
- 30 Commissioner shall adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

2 October 1, 1997.
