- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (b) (1) [The] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE
- 21 Secretary may arrange as the Secretary considers appropriate any benefit option for
- 22 inclusion in the Program.
- 23 (2) IN ARRANGING MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE BENEFIT
- 24 OPTIONS, THE SECRETARY SHALL ENSURE THAT, IN THE EVENT OF A CHANGE IN
- 25 ADMINISTRATORS OF THE STATE'S MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE PLAN,
- 26 ANY SUCCESSOR PLAN ADMINISTRATOR SHALL MAKE THE SAME CATEGORIES OF
- 27 HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS AVAILABLE TO COVERED INDIVIDUALS AS THE
- 28 PREVIOUS PLAN ADMINISTRATOR.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 30 October 1, 1997.
