HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

2 **Children's Day**

3 FOR the purpose of calling on the Governor to designate the first Sunday in October of
4 each year as Children's Day; and generally relating to the promotion and honor of
5 children.

6 WHEREAS, Children are vitally important to their families, to the State, and to the
7 future of this country; and

8 WHEREAS, No day is set aside to honor children or commemorate their
9 importance; now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the
11 Governor of Maryland is urged to designate the first Sunday in October of each year as
12 "Children's Day"; and be it further

13 RESOLVED, That the Governor is authorized and requested to issue a
14 proclamation calling on the people of the State of Maryland to observe the day with
15 appropriate ceremonies and activities; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of
17 Legislative Reference to the Honorable Parris N. Glendening, Governor of Maryland; the
18 Honorable Thomas V. Mike Miller, Jr., President of the Senate of Maryland; and the
19 Honorable Casper R. Taylor, Jr., Speaker of the House of Delegates.
