- 1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

- 3 FOR the purpose of calling on the Governor to designate the first Sunday in October of
- 4 each year as Children's Day; and generally relating to the promotion and honor of
- 5 children.
- 6 WHEREAS, Children are vitally important to their families, to the State, and to the
- 7 future of this country; and
- 8 WHEREAS, No day is set aside to honor children or commemorate their
- 9 importance; now, therefore, be it
- 10 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the
- 11 Governor of Maryland is urged to designate the first Sunday in October of each year as
- 12 "Children's Day"; and be it further
- 13 RESOLVED, That the Governor is authorized and requested to issue a
- 14 proclamation calling on the people of the State of Maryland to observe the day with
- 15 appropriate ceremonies and activities; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of
- 17 Legislative Reference to the Honorable Parris N. Glendening, Governor of Maryland; the
- 18 Honorable Thomas V. Mike Miller, Jr., President of the Senate of Maryland; and the
