HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

2 **Governor - Campaign Fund-Raising During the Legislative Session**

3 FOR the purpose of formally requesting the Governor to abstain from campaign fund-
4 raising during the 1997 Session of the General Assembly.

5 WHEREAS, The General Assembly abides by rules prohibiting the raising of
6 campaign funds while in session; and

7 WHEREAS, The Governor is not required to abstain from raising campaign funds
8 during the legislative session; and

9 WHEREAS, There is legislation now pending to prohibit the Governor from raising
10 funds during the legislative session; now, therefore, be it

11 **RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND**, That the
12 Governor is respectfully requested to refrain from fund-raising during the 1997 Session of
13 the General Assembly; and be it further

14 **RESOLVED**, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of
15 Legislative Reference to the Honorable Parris N. Glendening, Governor of Maryland; the
16 Honorable Thomas V. Mike Miller, Jr., President of the Senate of Maryland; and the
17 Honorable Casper R. Taylor, Jr., Speaker of the House of Delegates.
