- 1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

Motor Vehicle License Plates

- 3 FOR the purpose of requesting that the Motor Vehicle Administration study the
- 4 feasibility and advisability of changing the State's license plate design and issuance
- 5 procedures.

- WHEREAS, Annual vehicle registration fees provide a source of funds for road construction, maintenance, and improvement in the State; and
- 8 WHEREAS, It is in the best interests of the State to insure compliance with the
- 9 vehicle registration laws and, thus, a flow of revenues for highway construction,
- 10 maintenance, and improvements; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Compliance with the vehicle registration laws is higher when a state
- 12 maintains a regular license plate replacement program, including the regular changing of
- 13 colors and design; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Law enforcement personnel can more easily and visually determine
- 15 current compliance levels with motor vehicle registration laws if license plate colors and
- 16 designs are regularly changed; now, therefore, be it
- 17 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the
- 18 General Assembly requests that the Motor Vehicle Administration study the feasibility
- 19 and advisability of implementing a program for regular replacement of vehicle license
- 20 plates that includes changes in design and color, including consideration of the costs and
- 21 benefits of such a program; and be it further
- 22 RESOLVED, That the General Assembly requests that the Motor Vehicle
- 23 Administration submit the results of its study, including its recommendations for license
- 24 plate designs and colors, to the House Ways and Means Committee, the Senate Finance
- 25 Committee, and the Department of State Police by January 1, 1998; and be it further
- 26 RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of
- 27 Legislative Reference to the Administrator of the Motor Vehicle Administration.
