CHAPTER ____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Jewish Community Center of Greater Baltimore

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$500,000, the
- 4 proceeds to be used as a grant to the Jewish Community Center of Greater
- 5 Baltimore for certain acquisition, development, or improvement purposes; providing
- for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee
- 7 provide and expend a matching fund; providing that no proceeds of a loan or any
- 8 <u>matching funds may be used for religious purposes;</u> and providing generally for the
- 9 issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Jewish
- 14 Community Center of Greater Baltimore Loan of 1997 in a total principal amount equal
- 15 to the lesser of (i) \$500,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in
- 16 accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
- 17 and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of
- 18 Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124
- 19 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a
- 21 single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 22 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 24 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the
- 25 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on

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- 1 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,
- 2 for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees:
- 3 as a grant to the Jewish Community Center of Greater Baltimore (referred to hereafter in
- 4 this Act as "the grantee") for the repair, renovation, improvement, and expansion of the
- 5 educational, cultural, and recreational facilities at the Park Heights location of the
- 6 Center, which will allow the Center to expand and improve its services to senior citizens,
- 7 special needs populations, immigrants, and refugees, as well as to all the residents of the
- 8 Park Heights area.
- 9 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate
- 10 and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and when due
- 11 and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of
- 12 issuance of the bonds.
- 13 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 14 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching
- 15 fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or
- 16 indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of
- 17 the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to
- 18 the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching
- 19 fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works
- 20 shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1,
- 21 1999, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund
- 22 will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 23 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- 24 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in
- 25 this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified
- 26 by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 27 (6) No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be
- 28 used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, in connection with the design,
- 29 acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of sectarian
- 30 religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or department of
- 31 divinity for any religious denomination. Upon the request of the Board of Public Works,
- 32 the grantee shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none of the proceeds of
- 33 the loan or any matching funds has been or is being used for a purpose prohibited by this
- 34 Act.
- 35 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 36 June 1, 1997.
