- 16 (e) A clause required under this section for contract modification of or change
- 17 orders to a procurement contract for construction shall:
- 18 (1) make each contract modification or change order that affects the price
- 19 of the procurement contract subject to:
- 20 (i) prior written approval from the unit and any other person
- 21 responsible for the procurement contract; and
- 22 (ii) prior certification by the fiscal authority responsible for the unit
- 23 about:
- 24 1. the availability of money; and
- 25 2. the effect of the contract modification or change order on the

2	the fiscal authority discloses that the contract modification or change order will increase
