- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article 33 Election Code
- 15 2-11.
- 16 (C) (1) EACH BOARD SHALL PROVIDE TO THE POLLING PLACE IN EACH
- 17 PRECINCT GENERIC READING GLASSES FOR USE AT THE POLLING PLACE BY A
- 18 VOTER WHO REQUIRES VISUAL ASSISTANCE IN READING THE BALLOT.
- 19 (2) ON REQUEST BY A VOTER, THE JUDGES AT A POLLING PLACE SHALL
- 20 MAKE AVAILABLE THE GENERIC READING GLASSES REQUIRED BY PARAGRAPH (1)
- 21 OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
