# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Homeowners' Circuit Breaker Property Tax Credit - Notice

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Assessments and Taxation to provide

- 4 each county with certain notices of the homeowners' circuit breaker property tax
- 5 credit; requiring each county to include the notices in each property tax bill; and
- 6 generally relating to notice of the homeowners' circuit breaker property tax credit
- 7 program.

## 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 15 Article - Tax - Property

16 9-104.

- 17 (d) (1) When an assessment notice is sent to a homeowner, the Department18 shall give notice of the possible property tax credit under this section.
- 19 (2) (I) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE EACH COUNTY WITH20 NOTICES OF THE POSSIBLE PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (II) FOR TAXABLE YEARS BEGINNING AFTER JUNE 30, 1998, EACH
  COUNTY SHALL INCLUDE A NOTICE PROVIDED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS
  PARAGRAPH WITH EACH PROPERTY TAX BILL.

# 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 October 1, 1997.
