## 2 Police Dogs and Horses - Killing, Taunting, or Interfering With

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from intentionally killing a police dog or police
- 4 horse; prohibiting a person from intentionally taunting or otherwise interfering with
- 5 a police dog or police horse while the police dog or police horse is on duty;
- 6 establishing certain penalties; and generally relating to the killing of, taunting of, or
- 7 interfering with a police dog or police horse.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article 27 Crimes and Punishments
- 16 59B.
- 17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 18 INDICATED.
- 19 (2) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS A GOVERNMENTAL POLICE
- 20 FORCE, SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, SECURITY FORCE, OR OTHER AGENCY OF THE
- 21 UNITED STATES, A STATE, A COUNTY, OR A MUNICIPALITY OR OTHER POLITICAL
- 22 SUBDIVISION THAT HAS BY LAW THE AUTHORITY TO ENFORCE THE LAWS OF THE
- 23 UNITED STATES, A STATE, A COUNTY, OR A MUNICIPALITY OR OTHER POLITICAL
- 24 SUBDIVISION.
- 25 (3) "POLICE DOG" MEANS A DOG THAT IS REGISTERED WITH AND USED
- 26 BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS OFFICIAL DUTIES.
- 27 (4) "POLICE HORSE" MEANS A HORSE THAT IS REGISTERED WITH AND
- 28 USED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS OFFICIAL
- 29 DUTIES.

- 1 (B) (1) A PERSON MAY NOT INTENTIONALLY TAUNT OR OTHERWISE
- 2 INTERFERE WITH A POLICE DOG OR POLICE HORSE WHILE THE POLICE DOG OR
- 3 POLICE HORSE IS ON DUTY.
- 4 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SUBSECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 5 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500
- 6 OR A TERM OF IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
- 7 (C) (1) A PERSON MAY NOT INTENTIONALLY KILL A POLICE DOG OR 8 POLICE HORSE.
- 9 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SUBSECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 10 FELONY AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$7,000 OR A
- 11 TERM OF IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR BOTH.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 1997.
