- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Commercial Law
- 14 14-12B-02.
- 15 (b) (1) Each person who registers under this subtitle shall pay a registration fee 16 at the time of registration.
- 17 (2) (I) On September 1 of each year following the initial registration, each
- 18 registered person shall pay a renewal fee to the Division.
- 19 (II) THE RENEWAL FEE REQUIRED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF
- 20 THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY TO A REGISTERED PERSON WHO DOES NOT
- 21 COLLECT MORE THAN 1 MONTH'S PAYMENT IN ADVANCE FROM THE BUYER OF THE
- 22 HEALTH CLUB SERVICE.
- 23 (3) The fees for registration and renewal required under this subsection
- 24 shall be set by the Division:
- 25 (i) In an amount not exceeding \$800 for a person who is required to
- 26 purchase a surety bond or file an irrevocable letter of credit or cash under subsection (e)

- 1 (ii) In an amount not exceeding \$150 for a person who is exempt from 2 the requirement to purchase a surety bond or file an irrevocable letter of credit or cash 3 under subsection (e) of this section.
- 4 (4) The fees collected under this subsection may only be used for the 5 administration and enforcement of this subtitle.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 July 1, 1997.
