BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 17 **Article - Natural Resources** 18 10-301.1. 19 (a) (1) (i) On or after July 1, 1977 a person under 18 years of age may not 20 procure a hunting license or hunt in the State, unless the person has first been issued a 21 certificate of competency in firearms and hunter safety. 22 (ii) On or after July 1, 1977 a person, regardless of age, may not 23 procure a hunting license without producing a certificate of competency or a hunting

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- 1 license issued prior to July 1, 1977 or making out an affidavit that the person had such a 2 license.
- 3 (2) This section does not apply to nonresidents of Maryland who purchase a
- 4 hunting license in the State to hunt wild waterfowl. However, this does apply to
- 5 nonresidents of Maryland who purchase hunting licenses in the State to hunt other
- 6 wildlife.
- 7 (b) (1) The Department shall prescribe a course of instruction in conservation 8 and in competency and safety in the handling of firearms.
- 9 (2) The Department shall designate those persons or agencies authorized to
- $10\,$ give the course of instruction, and this designation shall be valid until revoked by the
- 11 Department. Those designated persons shall submit to the Department validated listings
- 12 naming all persons who have successfully completed the course of instruction.
- 13 (3) The Department shall issue a certificate of competency and safety to
- 14 each person who successfully completes the course of instruction, and the certificate shall
- 15 be valid until revoked by the Department.
- 16 (4) The Department may not issue a certificate of competency and safety to
- 17 an individual under the age of 18 unless the individual has completed satisfactorily the
- 18 course of instruction, or produces a certificate of competency or a hunting license issued
- 19 prior to July 1, 1978 or makes out an affidavit that the individual had such a license.
- 20 (c) (1) The Department shall institute and coordinate a statewide course of
- 21 instruction in conservation and in competency and safety in the handling of firearms, and
- 22 in so doing, the Department may cooperate with any political subdivision or with any
- 23 reputable organization having as 1 of its objectives the promotion of competency and
- 24 safety in the handling of firearms, such as the National Rifle Association and local rod
- 25 and gun clubs.
- 26 (2) The Department may conduct the course in hunter safety and issue the
- 27 certificates, using Department personnel or other persons at times and in areas where
- 28 other competent agencies are unable or unwilling to meet the demand for instruction.
- 29 (3) Any similar certificate, or hunting license, issued outside the State by a
- 30 governmental agency, shall be accepted as complying with the requirements of paragraph
- 31 (1) of the subsection, if the privileges are reciprocal for Maryland residents.
- 32 (d) The Department shall adopt regulations to provide for the course of
- 33 instruction and the issuance of the certificates consistent with the purpose of this section.
- 34 (e) (1) On or after July 1, 1977 any person who obtains a hunting license by
- 35 presenting a fictitious certificate of competency or who attempts to obtain a certificate of
- 36 competency or hunting license through fraud shall have his hunting privileges revoked by
- 37 the Department for a period not to exceed 1 year.
- 38 (2) Any applicant who is refused a certificate of competency under this
- 39 section may appeal the decision or action of the issuing unit to the Secretary.

	(f) (1) The Department or a person designated by the Department may issue a 1-year gratis hunting license to a Maryland resident under the age of 16 years who has successfully completed a hunter safety course.
