## 2 Courts - Immunity from Civil Liability - Local Boards of Supervisors of Elections

3 FOR the purpose of granting immunity from civil liability to the local boards of

- 4 supervisors of elections of the State, including the members of the boards, for
- 5 certain acts occurring within the scope of the boards' official authority; and
- 6 generally relating to the granting of immunity from civil liability for certain official
- 7 acts of the local boards of supervisors of elections and the members thereof.

## 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# 15 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

16 5-325.1.

17 (A) IN THIS SECTION "LOCAL BOARD OF ELECTIONS" MEANS THE BOARD OF
18 SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS OF EACH COUNTY OF THE STATE AND THE MEMBERS
19 OF EACH OF THOSE BOARDS.

(B) A LOCAL BOARD OF ELECTIONS, WHILE ACTING IN A DISCRETIONARY
(APACITY WITHOUT MALICE AND WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE BOARD'S OFFICIAL
AUTHORITY, IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY FOR ANY ACT OR OMISSION.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 1997.
