3 FOR the purpose of modifying a certain definition of "dealer" under the Maryland

- 4 Vehicle Law to exclude persons engaged exclusively in the sale of certain vehicles to
- 5 licensed funeral establishments, thereby exempting those persons from dealer
- 6 licensing requirements and other provisions applicable to licensed dealers
- 7 <u>exempting certain vehicle dealers from certain business and location requirements;</u>
- 8 <u>and generally relating to vehicle dealers</u>.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 5	(b) (1) "Dealer" means, except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, a dealer in vehicles of a type required to be registered under Title 13 of this article.

7 8	(i) A person who is in the business of buying, selling, or exchanging vehicles, including a person who during any 12 month period offers to sell five or more of
	these vehicles, the ownership of which was acquired for resale purposes; and

	personal or business use, if the vehicles are displayed at a fixed location used principally

6 (b) (1) As to trailers, semitrailers, motorcycles, CLASS C (FUNERAL AND

7 AMBULANCE) VEHICLES, or emergency vehicles as defined in § 11-118(2), (5), and (6) of

8 this article, the sale of these vehicles need not be the only or principal business conducted

9 from the fixed location, but shall be subject to any reasonable location requirements

10 determined by the Administration by rule or regulation.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 1997.
