3 FOR the purpose of altering the penalties for fraud in connection with the food stamp4 benefits program; and generally relating to the food stamp benefits program.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 12 Article 88A - Social Services Administration

13 89.

14 (a) No unauthorized person may sell or purchase federal food stamp program15 benefits.

(b) No person may knowingly buy or sell merchandise which has been purchasedwith federal food stamp program benefits.

(c) [Any person violating the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor
and upon conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000, or imprisonment not
exceeding six months, or both.]

(1) EVERY PERSON VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION IN
 WHICH THE VALUE OF THE MONEY OR GOODS INVOLVED IS \$500 \$1,000 OR MORE IS
 GUILTY OF A FELONY AND UPON CONVICTION SHALL:

4 (I) MAKE FULL RESTITUTION OF THE MONEY OR GOODS
5 UNLAWFULLY RECEIVED <u>OR PERFORM COMMUNITY SERVICE, AS DETERMINED BY</u>
6 <u>THE COURT;</u> AND

7 (II) BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000 OR8 IMPRISONMENT FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 5 YEARS OR BOTH.

9 (2) EVERY PERSON VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION IN
10 WHICH THE VALUE OF THE MONEY OR GOODS IS LESS THAN \$500 \$1,000 IS GUILTY OF
11 A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON A CONVICTION SHALL:

(I) MAKE FULL RESTITUTION OF THE MONEY OR GOODS
 UNLAWFULLY RECEIVED <u>OR PERFORM COMMUNITY SERVICE, AS DETERMINED BY</u>
 <u>THE COURT;</u> AND

(II) BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 ORIMPRISONMENT FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 3 YEARS OR BOTH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 1997.
