- 2 Weights and Measures Method of Sale of Poultry and Flour Products
- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the method of sale of certain commodities and removing a 4 certain label requirement under the Weights and Measures Law; and generally
- 5 relating to regulation of weights and measures.
- 6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Agriculture
- 14 11-310.
- 15 (a) (1) Except as provided in this subsection or as specified by the Secretary,
- 16 any meat, meat product, poultry, and all seafood offered or exposed for sale or sold as
- 17 food shall be offered or exposed for sale and sold by weight.
- 18 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (1) of this subsection, the
- 19 following products may be offered or exposed for sale or sold by weight, measure, or
- 20 count:
- 21 (i) Shellfish;
- 22 (ii) Items for consumption on the premises where sold;
- 23 (iii) Items sold as 1 of [3] 2 or more different elements, excluding
- 24 condiments, that comprise a ready-to-eat meal sold as a unit for consumption elsewhere
- 25 than on the premises where sold; and
- 26 (iv) Cooked and ready-to-eat WHOLE CHICKEN OR chicken parts that
- 27 are prepared on the premises.

- 1 (b) When meat, poultry, or seafood is combined with or associated with some 2 other food element to form either a distinctive food product or a food combination, the
- 3 food product or combination shall be offered or exposed for sale, and sold by weight, the
- $4\,$ quantity representation may be the total weight of the product or combination and a
- 5 quantity representation is not required for each element of the product or combination.
- 6 [However, ready-to-cook, whole carcass, stuffed poultry, ready-to-cook stuffed poultry
- 7 roasts, rolls, bars, and logs, and ready-to-cook stuffed poultry products designated by
- 8 terms of similar meaning, the label shall show the total net weight of the poultry product
- 9 and, in close proximity, a statement specifying the minimum weight of poultry in the
- 10 product.]

- 12 [When in package form, and when packed, possessed, offered, or exposed for sale
- 13 or sold at retail,] WHEN OFFERED OR EXPOSED FOR SALE, wheat flour, whole wheat
- 14 flour, graham flour, self-rising wheat flour, phosphated wheat flour, bromated flour,
- 15 enriched flour, enriched self-rising flour, enriched bromated flour, corn flour, cornmeal,
- 16 and hominy grits shall be [packaged only in units of 2, 5, 10, 25, 50, or 100 pounds, or
- 17 multiples of 100 pounds, avoirdupois weight. However, this section does not apply to
- 18 prepared ready-mixed flours and meals, and special cake flours in packages the net
- 19 contents of which are less than 5 pounds] SOLD BY WEIGHT ONLY.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 1997.
