- 3 FOR the purpose of allowing the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to obtain a
- 4 court order to have an individual being treated for tuberculosis to be placed in a less
- 5 restrictive environment; allowing an individual imprisoned for violation of
- 6 tuberculosis treatment to be released and treated in a less restrictive environment
- 7 under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the treatment of tuberculosis.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Health General
- 16 18-325.
- 17 (c) An individual who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a
- 18 misdemeanor and on conviction shall be imprisoned in a penal institution with facilities
- 19 for tuberculosis treatment until the Secretary or the Health Department of Baltimore
- 20 City finds that the condition of the individual no longer endangers the health of the
- 21 community[.], OR THE SECRETARY OBTAINS A COURT ORDER THAT STATES THAT
- 22 THE INDIVIDUAL:
- 23 (1) IS TO BE MOVED TO A SPECIFIED LESS RESTRICTIVE SETTING FOR
- 24 CONTINUATION OF TREATMENT;
- 25 (2) MUST COMPLY WITH THE TREATMENT UNTIL THE SECRETARY
- 26 DETERMINES THE TREATMENT HAS BEEN COMPLETED;
- 27 (3) MAY NOT BEHAVE IN A DISORDERLY MANNER OR LEAVE THE
- 28 PLACEMENT UNTIL THE SECRETARY DETERMINES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS
- 29 COMPLETED THE TREATMENT; AND

- 1 (4) FOLLOWING A HEARING, WILL BE REIMPRISONED UNTIL THE
- 2 SECRETARY DETERMINES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS COMPLETED THE
- 3 TREATMENT, IF THE INDIVIDUAL DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THE
- 4 ORDER.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 1997.
