BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 **Article - Estates and Trusts** 14 13-707. 15 (a) Persons are entitled to appointment as guardian of the person according to 16 the following priorities: 17 (1) A person, agency, or corporation nominated by the disabled person if 18 the disabled person was 16 years old or older when the disabled person signed the 19 designation and, in the opinion of the court, the disabled person had sufficient mental 20 capacity to make an intelligent choice at the time the disabled person executed the 21 designation;
