A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Morgan State University - Procurement Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of expanding the procurement authority of Morgan State University to
4 include certain supplies funded by proceeds from State general obligation bonds.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
6 Article - State Finance and Procurement
7 Section 12-107(b)(8)
8 Annotated Code of Maryland
9 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

13 12-107.

14 (b) Subject to the authority of the Board, jurisdiction over procurement is as
15 follows:

16 (8) Morgan State University, without the approval of any of the other
17 primary procurement units, may engage in the procurement of:

18 (i) supplies for the University, including motor vehicles and, to the
19 extent provided by Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, information processing supplies, but
20 excluding[:

21 1. supplies funded by the proceeds from State general
22 obligation bonds; and

23 2.] insurance;

24 (ii) services for the University, including information processing
25 services to the extent provided in Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, but excluding banking
26 and financial services under the authority of the State Treasurer under item (1) of this
27 subsection;

1 (iii) construction and construction related services for the University,
2 regardless of the source of funds, to the extent that the Board grants authority over
3 specific projects or classes of projects; and

4 (iv) leases of real property for the University if the lease payments are
5 not paid from the General Fund of the State.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 July 1, 1997.
