Morgan State University - Procurement Authority

- 3 FOR the purpose of expanding the procurement authority of Morgan State University to
- 4 include certain supplies funded by proceeds from State general obligation bonds.
- 5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 6 Article State Finance and Procurement
- 7 Section 12-107(b)(8)
- 8 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 9 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 12 Article - State Finance and Procurement

- 13 12-107.
- 14 (b) Subject to the authority of the Board, jurisdiction over procurement is as
- 15 follows:
- 16 (8) Morgan State University, without the approval of any of the other
- 17 primary procurement units, may engage in the procurement of:
- 18 (i) supplies for the University, including motor vehicles and, to the
- 19 extent provided by Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, information processing supplies, but
- 20 excluding[:
- 21 1. supplies funded by the proceeds from State general
- 22 obligation bonds; and
- 23 2.] insurance;
- 24 (ii) services for the University, including information processing
- 25 services to the extent provided in Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, but excluding banking
- 26 and financial services under the authority of the State Treasurer under item (1) of this
- 27 subsection;

- 1 (iii) construction and construction related services for the University,
  2 regardless of the source of funds, to the extent that the Board grants authority over
  3 specific projects or classes of projects; and
  4 (iv) leases of real property for the University if the lease payments are
  5 not paid from the General Fund of the State.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 July 1, 1997.
