CHAPTER ____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Morgan State University - Procurement Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of expanding the procurement authority of Morgan State University to
4 include certain supplies funded by proceeds from State general obligation bonds.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
6 Article - State Finance and Procurement
7 Section 12-107(b)(8)
8 Annotated Code of Maryland
9 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

13 12-107.

14 (b) Subject to the authority of the Board, jurisdiction over procurement is as
15 follows:

16 (8) Morgan State University, without the approval of any of the other
17 primary procurement units, may engage in the procurement of:

18 (i) supplies for the University, including motor vehicles and, to the
19 extent provided by Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, information processing supplies, but
20 excluding[:

1 1. supplies funded by the proceeds from State general
2 obligation bonds; and

3 2.] insurance;

4 (ii) services for the University, including information processing
5 services to the extent provided in Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, but excluding banking
6 and financial services under the authority of the State Treasurer under item (1) of this
7 subsection;

8 (iii) construction and construction related services for the University,
9 regardless of the source of funds, to the extent that the Board grants authority over
10 specific projects or classes of projects; and

11 (iv) leases of real property for the University if the lease payments are
12 not paid from the General Fund of the State.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 July 1, 1997.
