A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Public School Construction - Funding**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State to provide a certain level of funding for public
4 school construction projects and public school capital improvements in Prince
5 George's County for certain fiscal years.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Education**

19 5-301.

20 (b) The State shall pay the costs in excess of available federal funds of all public
21 school construction projects and public school capital improvements in each county if:

22 (1) The projects or improvements have been approved by the Board of
23 Public Works; and

24 (2) Contracts have been executed on or after July 1, 1971 for the projects or
25 improvements.

26 5-307.

27 (A) The Interagency Committee on Public School Construction shall assist the
28 Prince George's County Board of Education in developing an education facility master

1 plan that encourages and supports the neighborhood school concept to improve the
2 quality of education for all students in Prince George's County.

3 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE STATE
4 CONTRIBUTION TO PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS AND PUBLIC SCHOOL
5 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL BE AT LEAST
6 \$20,000,000 A YEAR FOR FISCAL YEAR 1998 AND FISCAL YEAR 1999.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 June 1, 1997.
